The CGB is responsible for the appropriate governance of SaaS through to IaaS implementations. It assumes the role of what the NIST calls the Cloud Broker function that assists with the secure on-boarding of Cloud services.

CGB members act as a single, authoritative source of all Cloud services consumed by your company. Training offerings that should be taken by all members of the board consists of:
